 - Need to continue to file SOS and DOJ forms until we have become a division
- REFORMANET listserv will only be available to paying members starting next year (extended from Oct 1)
 - **ACTION ITEM:** Statement as state chapter to REFORMA National Executive Committee advocating to continue open access to listserv.
- Newport Public Library won Noche de Cuentos mini grant from REFORMA National!
 - pick-up storytelling kits + virtual Alex Lluminquiga / Guatemalan community member-hosted event: shared the ancestral music, dance, stories and culture of the indigenous people of the Andes
- Star attended SLIM Advisory meeting at Emporia
 - Fall 2020 classes will all be virtual. Planning for Spring 2021 in person / as usual
